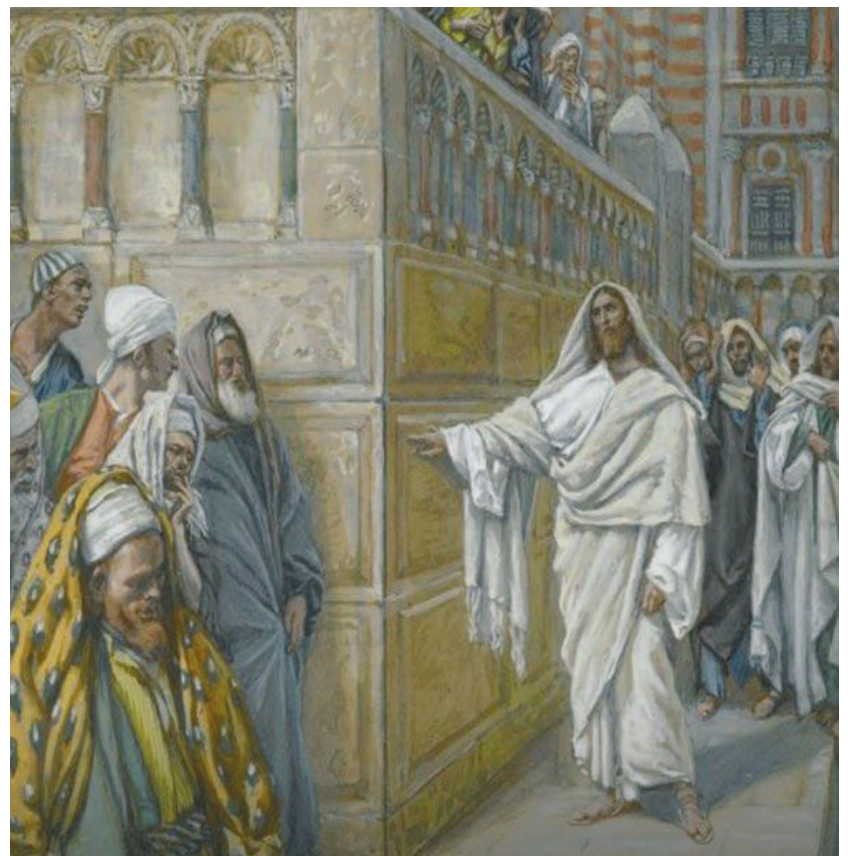

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Jesus' parables are much stranger than most people realize. This week is an attention-getting example. He tells the religious leaders a parable about a completely absurd situation. Blood-thirsty and insane tenants violently abuse and kill the servants of their landlord. Inexplicably, the owner keeps sending them more victims of increasing value — up to and including his own son. Weird.

Usually, we hear this parable and assume it's an allegory: Jesus is the murdered son, the servants the prophets, etc. Fair enough. But notice — and here is where the weirdness deepens — Jesus seems to disagree with the Pharisees' interpretation that the landowner should and will punish the inheritance-obsessed murderers. So, is Jesus praising the psychotic and greedy murderers?! You can imagine the furrowed brows and deriding laughter as the scoffing crowd shuffles away.

If we stay with this tough parable, perhaps this truth emerges: God wants us to have an over-the-top obsession with a totally undeserved inheritance. Of course, we are forbidden to use violence. But the para-

ble's violence gets our attention because it highlights the crazy goodness of the landowner. Jesus reveals that God is not merely in the business of rewarding the good and punishing the bad. He is playing a much stranger game — one marked by a kind of over-the-top mercy, a breathtaking giving of what is not deserved. What would our week look like if we embraced this kind of desire for God's kingdom on earth, even if others think we're nuts? This week let's seek God's kingdom with a passionate confidence in God's desire to give the good things we don't deserve. — Father John Muir ©LPi

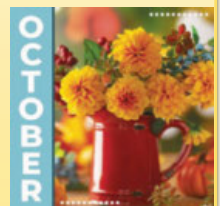

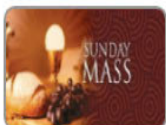

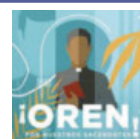

History of the Rosary

What is the history of the rosary?

Where did this prayer come from?

Although a longstanding tradition attributed the rosary to Saint Dominic and the Dominican Order, the practice of using beads to count prayers predates the Dominicans by a few hundred years. In fact, it seems that what we now think of as the rosary (which means “garland of roses”) was first developed by illiterate peasants and religious brothers and sisters as a way of offering 150 “Our Fathers” to replace the praying of the 150 psalms in the Divine Office.

The practice of reciting 150 Hail Marys (which was later subdivided into 15 decades of 10 Hail Marys) arose during the late Middle Ages. Devotion to the rosary began to flourish in the nineteenth century, especially as new devotions to Mary began to spread throughout Europe and the New World. An annual liturgical celebration of Our Lady of the Rosary was introduced into the Church calendar in 1573 and it has been observed on the date of October 7 since 1913.

In the apostolic letter *On the Most Holy Rosary*, Pope Saint John Paul II not only added five new mysteries to the traditional fifteen, but he also reminded Catholics that the rosary is, at its core, an opportunity to go deeper into the life of Jesus: “The rosary, though clearly Marian in character, is at heart a Christocentric prayer ... It has all the *depth of the Gospel message in its entirety*, of which it can be said to be a compendium. It is an echo of Mary’s prayer, her perennial *Magnificat* ... With the rosary, the Christian people sit at the school of Mary and are led to contemplate the beauty of the face of Christ and to experience the depths of his love” (no. 1). ©LPi

Historia del Rosario

¿Cuál es la historia del rosario?

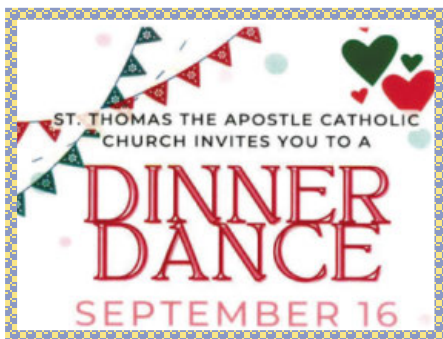
¿De dónde vino esta oración?

Aunque una larga tradición atribuyó el rosario a Santo Domingo y a la Orden Dominicana, la práctica de usar cuentas para contar oraciones es anterior a los dominicos por unos cientos de años. De hecho, parece que lo que ahora consideramos el rosario (que significa “guirnalda de rosas”) fue desarrollado por primera vez por campesinos analfabetos y hermanos y hermanas religiosos como una forma de ofrecer 150 “Padres Nuestros” para reemplazar la oración del 150 salmos en el Oficio Divino.

La práctica de recitar 150 Avemarías (que luego se subdividió en 15 décadas de 10 Avemarías) surgió durante la Baja Edad Media. La devoción al rosario comenzó a florecer en el siglo XIX, especialmente cuando nuevas devociones a María comenzaron a extenderse por Europa y el Nuevo Mundo. En 1573 se introdujo en el calendario de la Iglesia una celebración litúrgica anual de Nuestra Señora del Rosario y se observa en la fecha del 7 de octubre desde 1913.

En la carta apostólica *Sobre el Santísimo Rosario*, el Papa San Juan Pablo II no sólo añadió cinco nuevos misterios a los quince tradicionales, sino que también recordó a los católicos que el rosario es, en esencia, una oportunidad para profundizar en la vida de Jesús. : “El rosario, aunque de carácter claramente mariano, es en el fondo una oración cristocéntrica... Tiene toda la profundidad del mensaje evangélico en su totalidad, del que se puede decir que es un compendio. Es un eco de la oración de María, de su perenne *Magnificat*... Con el rosario, el pueblo cristiano se sienta en la escuela de María y es llevado a contemplar la belleza del rostro de Cristo y a experimentar la profundidad de su amor” (n. 1). ©LPi

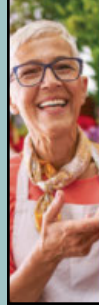

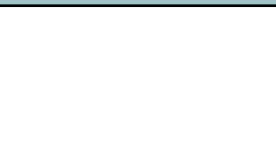
